

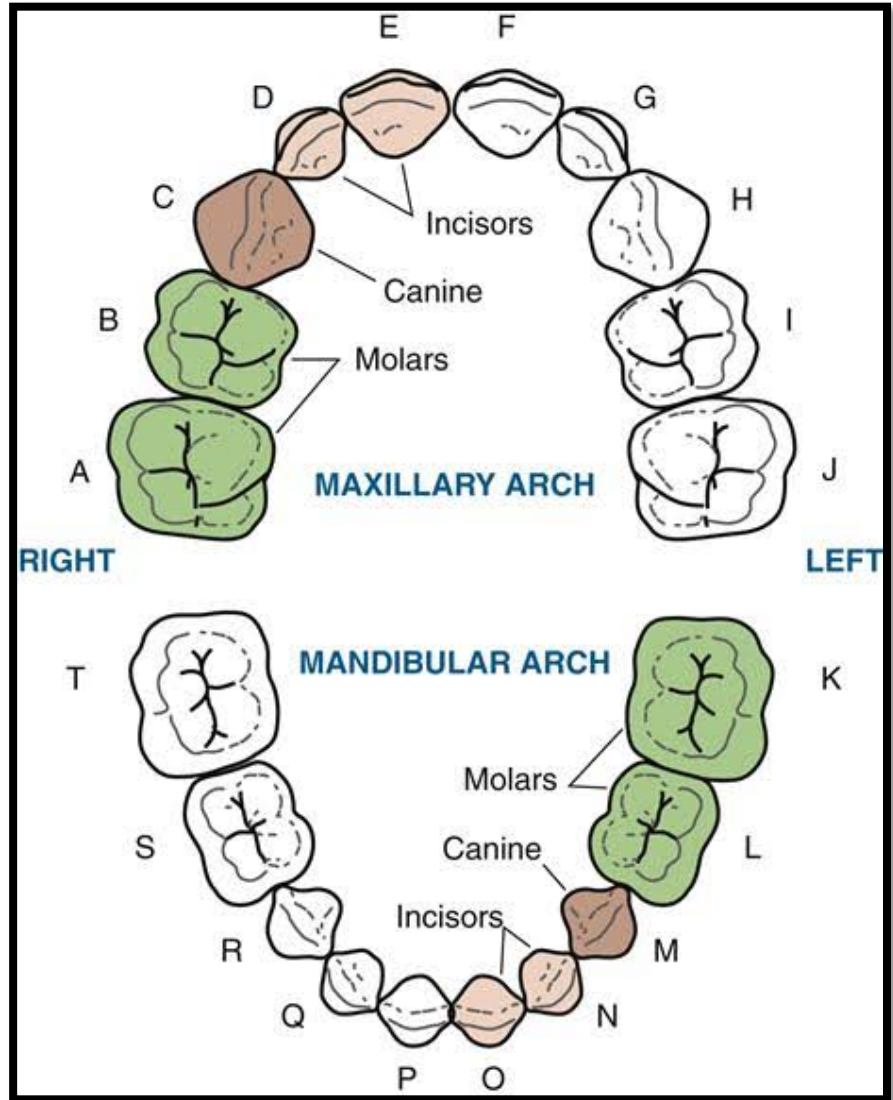

Dentition

- Two dentitions
 1. Primary or Deciduous
 2. Secondary or Permanent

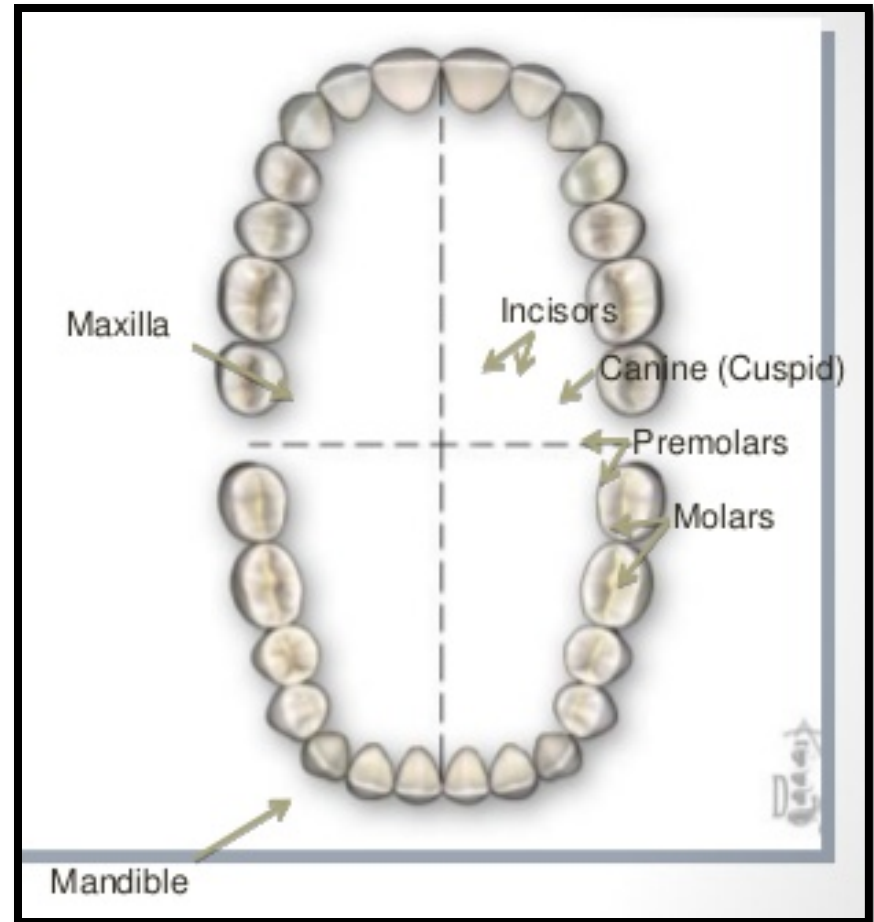
Primary Dentition

- Consist of 20 teeth
- Starts erupting from 6 months of age
- Completes eruption by 3 years of age



Permanent Dentition

- Consists of 32 teeth
- Starts erupting from 6 years of age
- Almost completes its eruption by 14 years
- Wisdom tooth alone erupts by 17-25 years of age

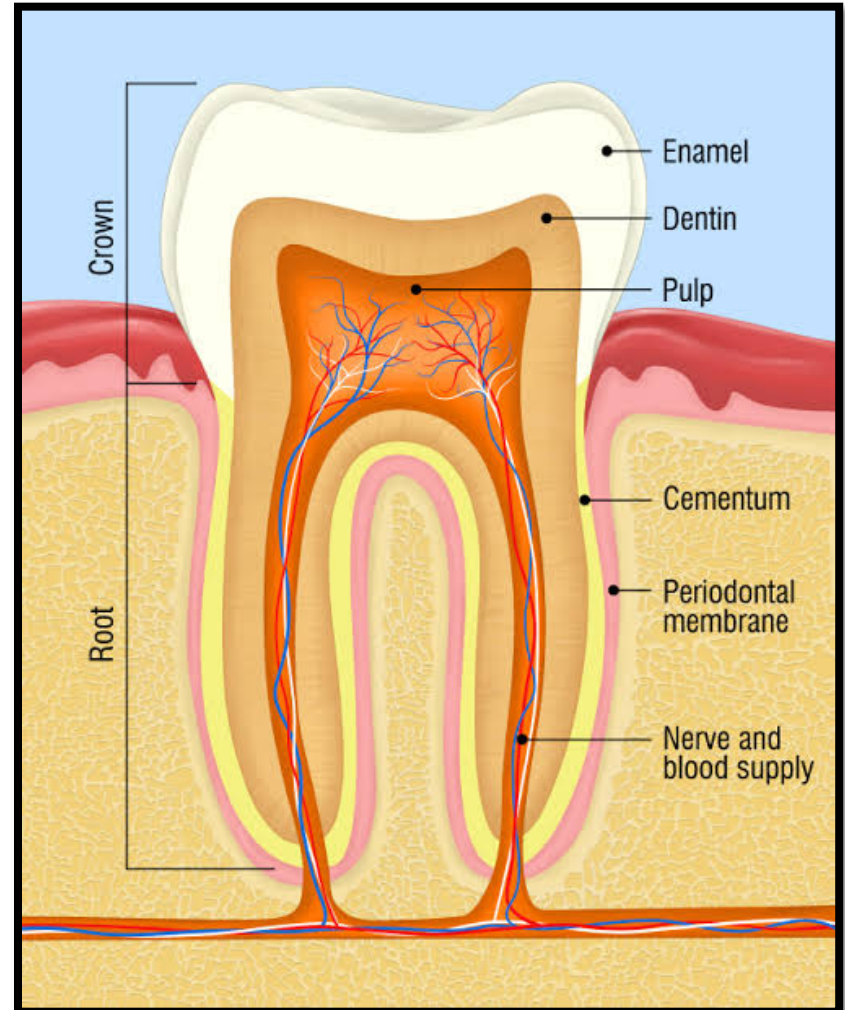


Tooth Anatomy

- Made up of 3 elements
 - a. Water
 - b. Organic materials
 - c. Inorganic materials

Tooth Anatomy

- 4 main dental tissue
 - a. Enamel
 - b. Dentin
 - c. Pulp
 - d. Cementum



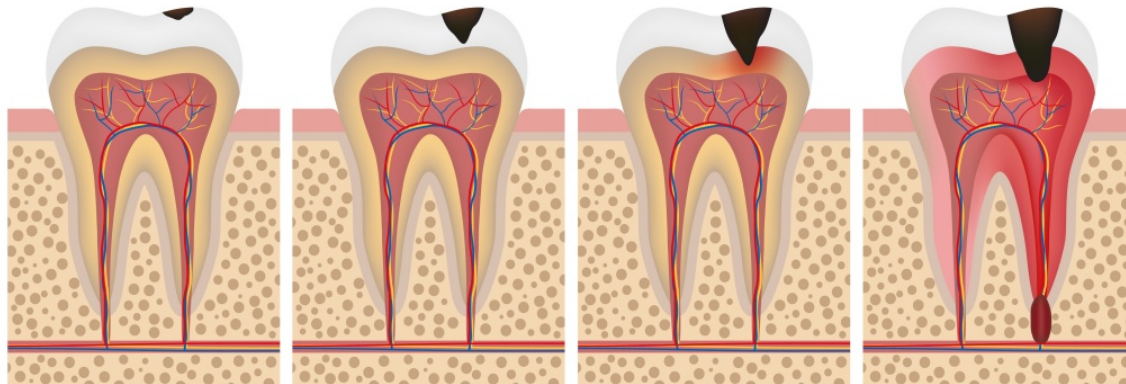

1. Decay in enamel 2. Advanced decay 3. Decay in dentin 4. Decay in pulp

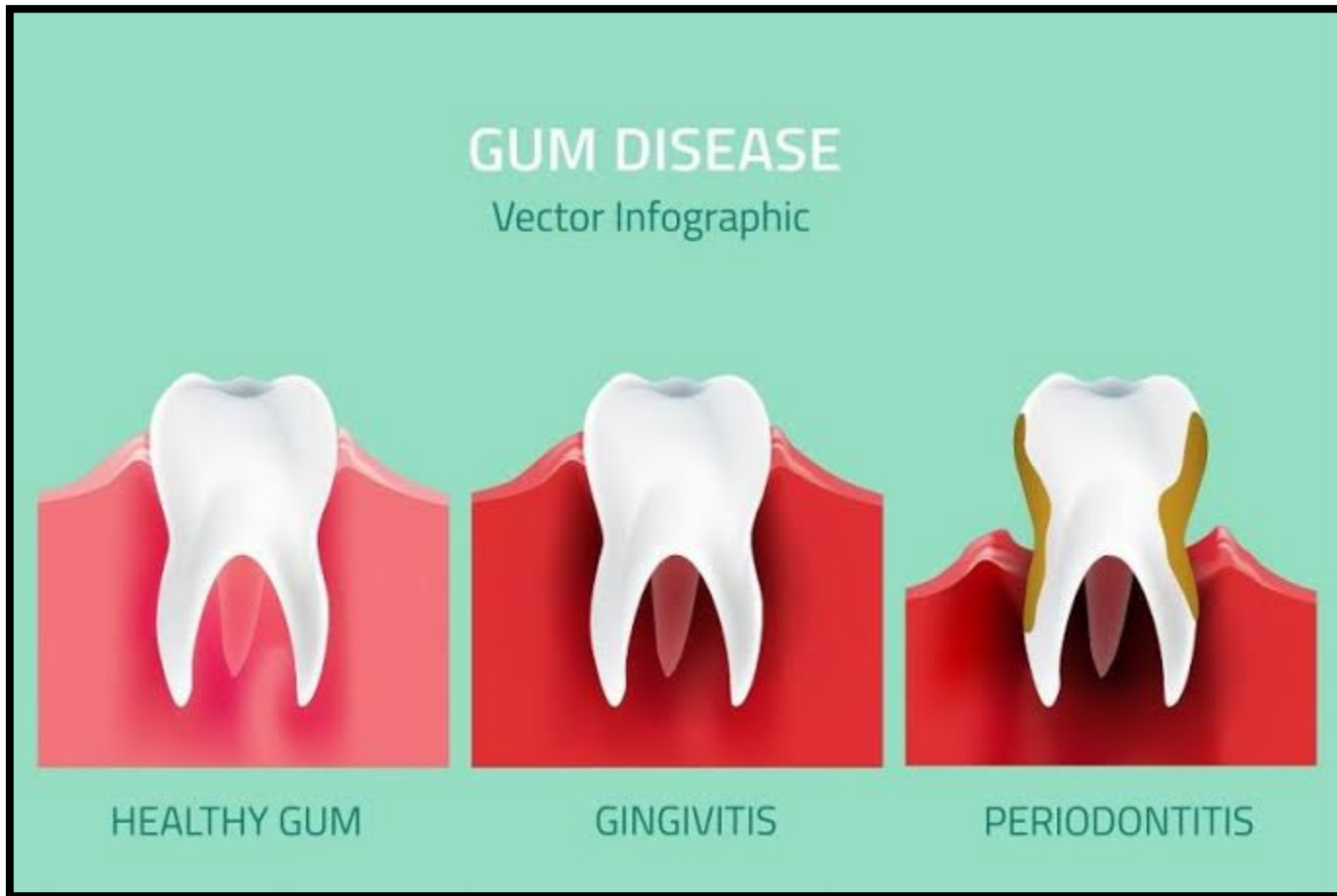

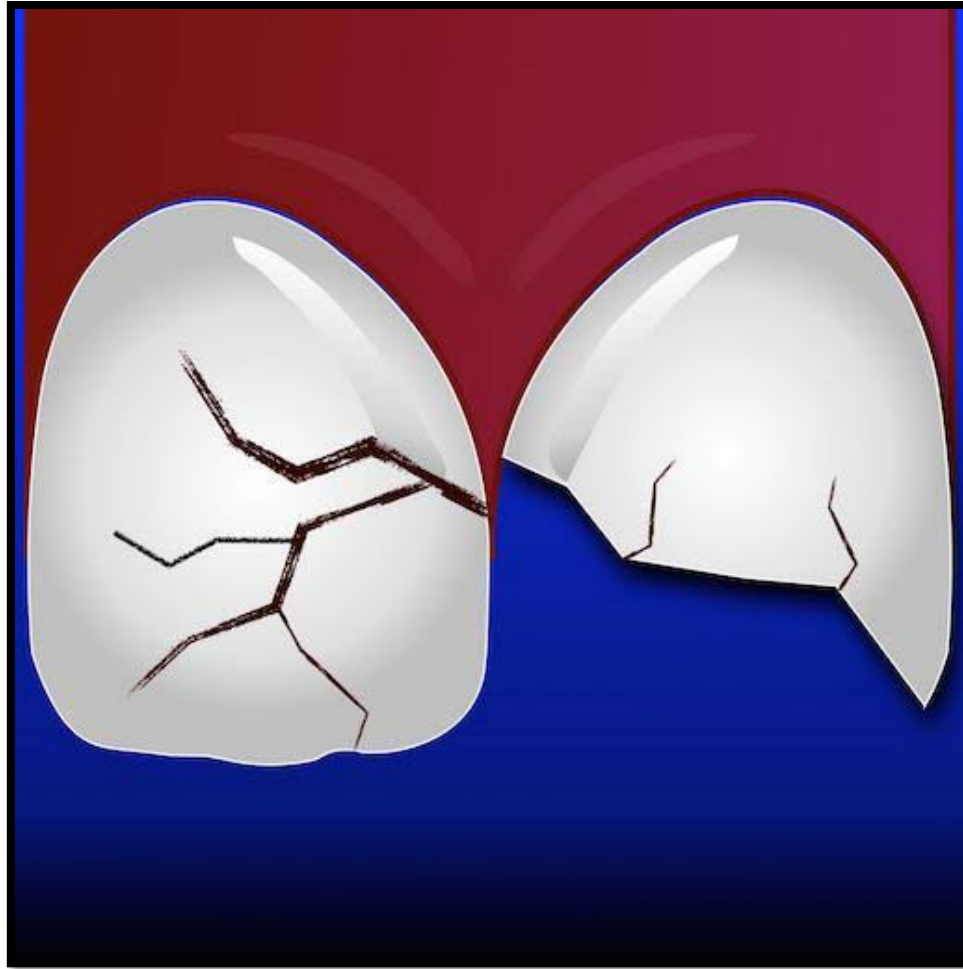

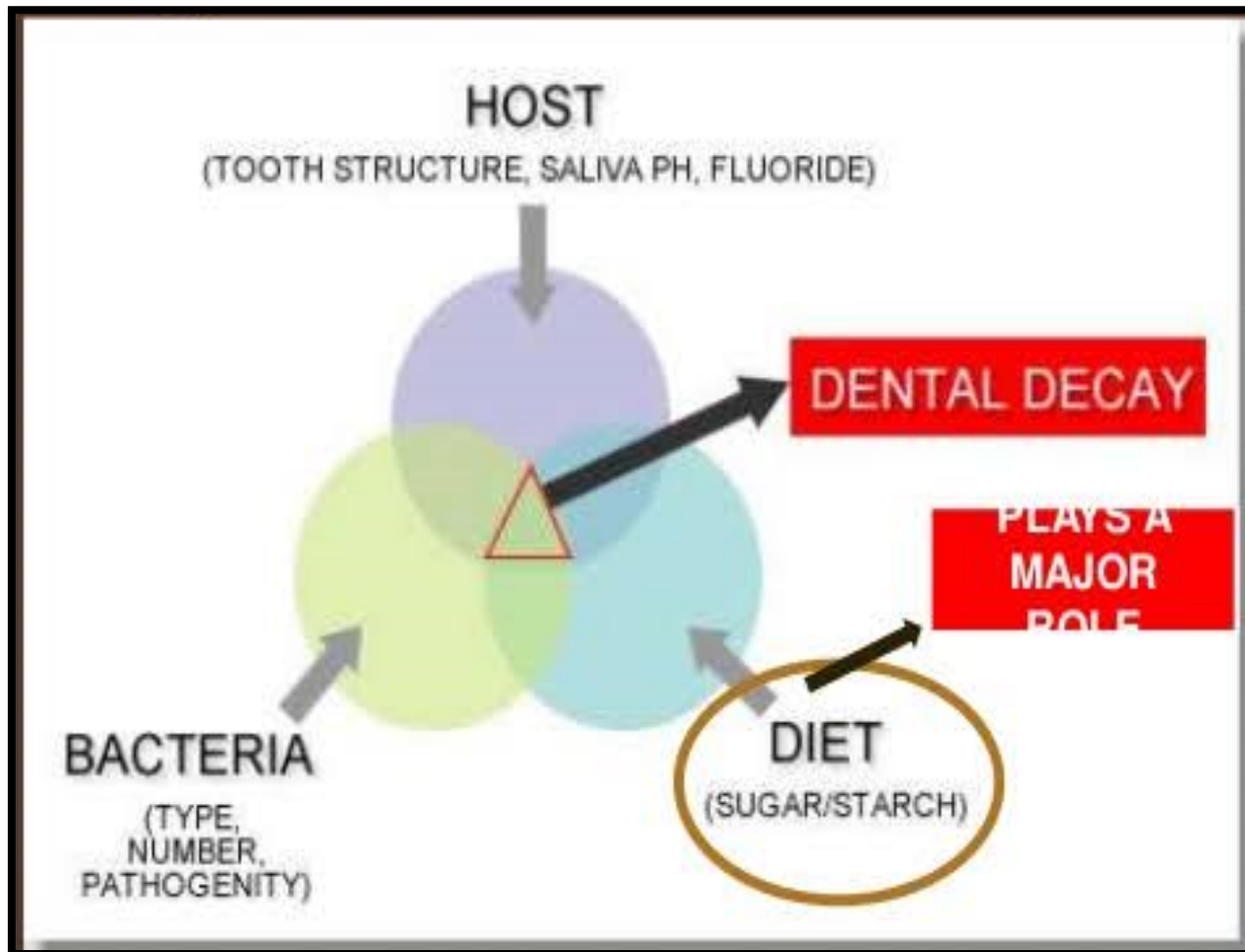

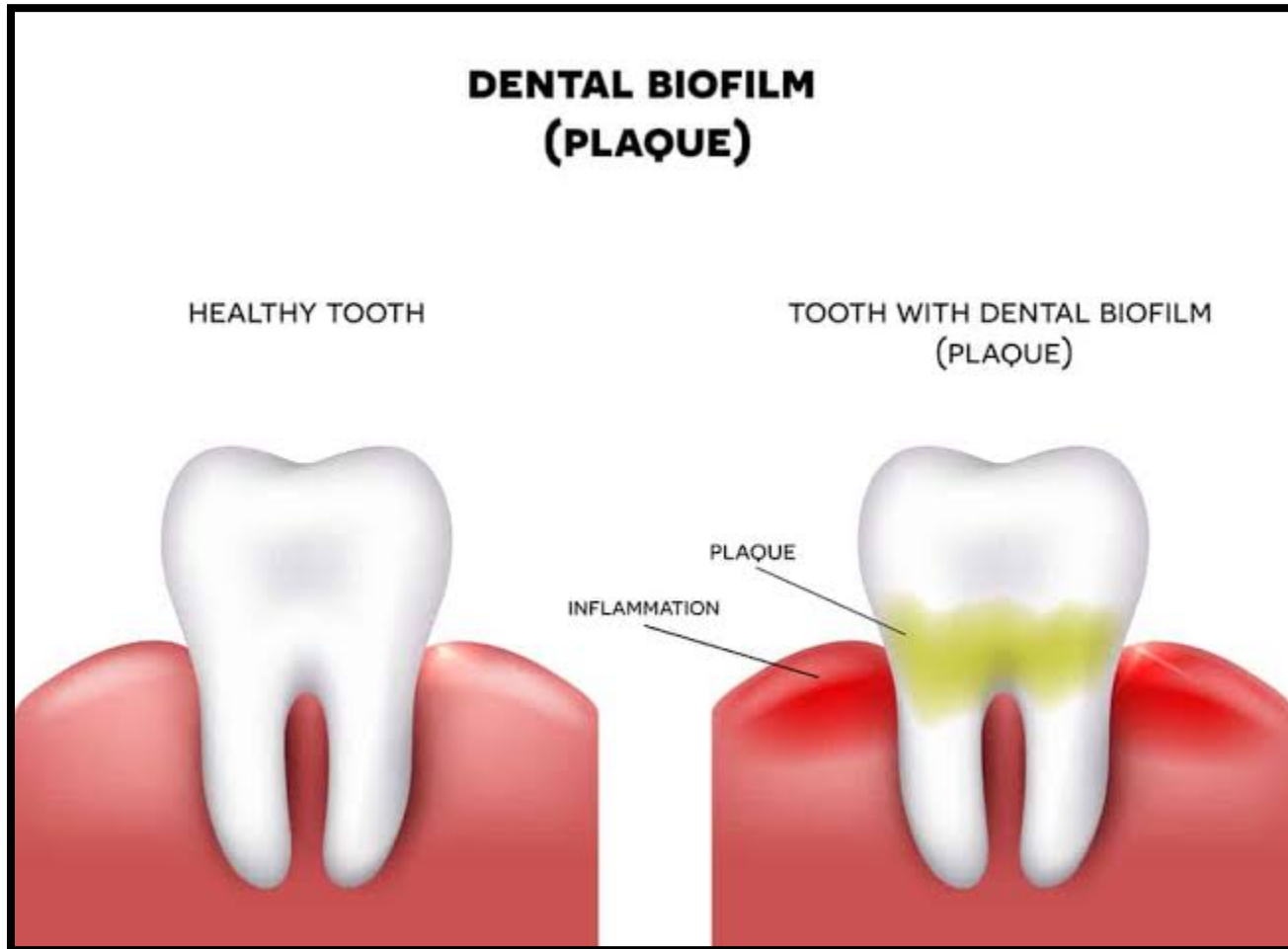
